

PROPOSED WORDING for 2015 NV Legislature

Amendment to NRS 639.0125

7.) A Nevada Licensed Athletic Trainer who:

- a. holds a Nevada State License issued by the Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers and
- b. is authorized by the State Board of Athletic Trainers to possess, administer and dispense over the counter pharmaceuticals, Hypodermics, injectable pharmaceuticals, emergency bronchial inhalers and Epi-pens or
- c. provide iontophoresis or preparations through the use of therapeutic ultrasound as directed by physician (NRS 630/633).

NAC 640B.015 Certification to Possess, Dispense and Administer Over the Counter Pharmaceuticals

The Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers will issue a certificate to possess, administer and dispense over the counter pharmaceuticals, Epi-pen and emergency bronchial inhalers, if the Practioner:

- a. Submits to the Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers his or her written standing orders by his or her directing physician to possess, administer and dispense over the counter pharmaceuticals. Orders must include the Physician Nevada State Medical License

NAC 640B.016 Certification to Possess hypodermics, sharp tools and injectables to be used by physician or directed physician extender

The Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers will issue a certificate to possess hypodermics, sharp tools and injectables to be used by physician or directed physician extender if the Practioner:

- a. Submits to the Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers his or her written standing orders by his or her directing physician to possess hypodermics, sharp tools and injectables. Orders must include the Physician Nevada State Medical License.

NAC 640B.017 Certification to possess and administer iontophoresis or phonoporesis

The Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers will issue a certificate to possess and administer iontophoresis and phonoporesis if the Practioner:

- a. Submits to the Nevada State Board of Athletic Trainers his or her written standing orders to possess and administer iontophoresis or phonoporesis signed off by directing physician (NRS630/633)
- b. Must have a valid physician prescription for compound on file that will be transmitted via iontophoresis or phonoporesis within the medical record of patient
